Share Wokingham offers fresh produce, like bread and vegetables for those who need it. These are surplus stock from local supermarkets.

Each week SHARE helps over 2000 people in our community who need support with food by redistributing an incredible 40 tonnes of food from local food suppliers that would otherwise go to waste.

We are proud that we now have fifteen community fresh food and pantry sites, serving over 600 households a week with free access to fresh food.
